DAY 1



From City to Coastline

Your adventure begins in the heart of Perth, where our friendly driver-guide greets you with a smile and a comfortable minibus ready to take you south. As the city fades into open road, the scenery transforms into wide golden fields, gumtree forests, and glimpses of the glittering Indian Ocean.

Busselton Jetty

Our first stop is the charming seaside town of Busselton, the northern gateway to the South West. Here lies Busselton Jetty, a 1.84-kilometre masterpiece of timber and history – the longest wooden jetty in the Southern Hemisphere. Stroll along its length or hop aboard the miniature train to the end of the jetty, where the Underwater Observatory awaits. Here, over 300 marine species dance in turquoise waters: soft corals, shimmering fish, delicate seahorses – nature's own aquarium.

Shelter Brewing Co.

Lunch today is at Shelter Brewing Co., Busselton's most celebrated beachfront restaurant and brewery. The entire building is a modern industrial glasshouse – wide open spaces, soaring ceilings, and panoramic windows framing the Indian Ocean just metres away.

Here, freshness is the philosophy. The menu celebrates local farmers, fishers, and brewers. Begin your meal with a seafood platter brimming with grilled Augusta prawns, buttery and sweet; tender Busselton squid with a light lemon aioli; and oysters so fresh they taste like a kiss of the sea.

Prefer something heartier? The grass-fed beef burger is a house favourite — juicy local beef topped with caramelised onions, house relish, cheddar, and crisp lettuce, served with sweet potato fries.

Pair your meal with a chilled pint of Shelter Pale Ale, whose bright citrus and tropical notes mirror the sea breeze. And if you prefer something softer, their homemade ginger beer is a refreshing delight.

Explore Busselton

After lunch, you may stroll the lively Busselton foreshore, browse small boutiques and artisanal market stalls, or linger in a nearby café with a flat white — a gentle moment to soak in the atmosphere.

Higgins Lane Motel (or similar standard)

In the late afternoon, we continue south to Margaret River. Upon arrival, check into Higgins Lane Motel (or similar standard), a quiet and stylish boutique accommodation just steps from the town's main street. Each room is elegantly appointed with plush bedding, rain showers, eco-friendly toiletries, and private patios or balconies overlooking leafy surroundings. Its central location makes it perfect for evening strolls to cafés, wine bars, and restaurants.



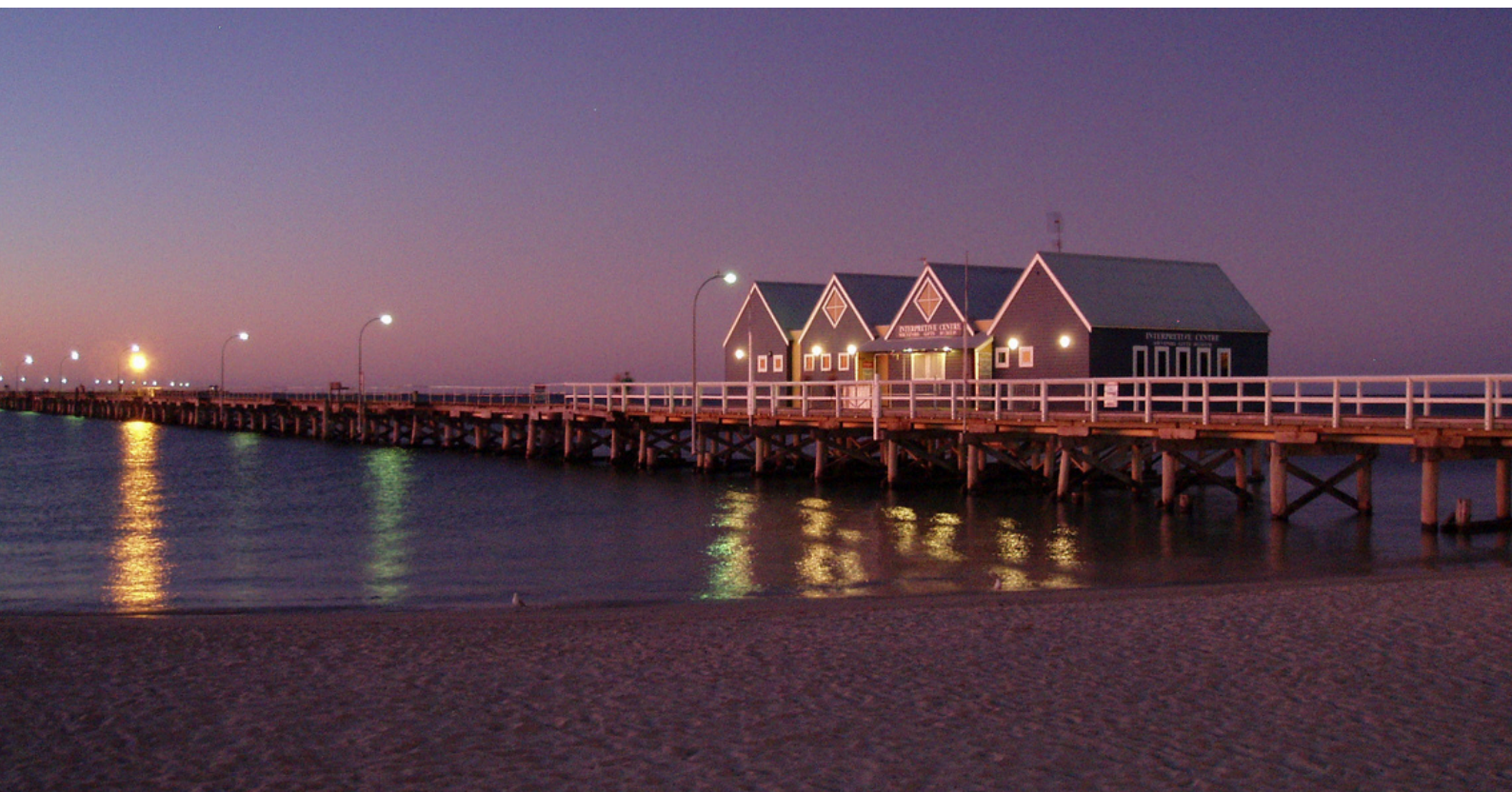
Dinner

Dinner is free and flexible this evening — your guide will offer personalised recommendations depending on your preferences.

One of the beloved options is Settlers Tavern, a local icon housed in a 1936 heritage building with timber beams, warm lighting, and a lively bar filled with locals. Their menu blends rustic charm with modern Australian flavours:

- Slow-roasted lamb shoulder, rich and fragrant with rosemary, served over silky parsnip mash with a red wine jus.
- Pan-seared barramundi, its skin crisp and golden, paired with lemon beurre blanc and roasted heirloom vegetables.
- Wild berry cheesecake or panna cotta for a gentle, fruity finish.

For those wanting something quieter, Margaret River also offers intimate bistros, modern wine bars, and casual wood-fired pizza kitchens — perfect for a relaxed first night in town.



Margaret River mornings are crisp, clear, and filled with birdsong. A gentle breeze carries the scent of eucalyptus and the promise of a beautiful day ahead.

Margaret River Bakery

Breakfast is at Margaret River Bakery, a local treasure. The bakery's vintage European decor — floral china, mismatched chairs, pastel walls — creates a whimsical, cozy atmosphere that feels like stepping into a storybook café.

Enjoy warm sourdough toast topped with smashed avocado, feta, and heirloom tomatoes drizzled with olive oil; a flaky croissant filled with house-made berry jam and clotted cream; or their famous cinnamon scrolls fresh from the oven. Pair your breakfast with a flat white or single-origin pour-over brewed from local roasters.

Margaret River Distilling Company

Next, visit the internationally acclaimed Margaret River Distilling Company, awarded at the San Francisco World Spirits Competition. This distillery is known for its whiskies and gins infused with native botanicals, capturing the spirit of Western Australia in every drop.

DAY 2



Distilling Craft, Underground Wonders & An Omakase Masterpiece





A guided tour reveals the secrets behind their craft — gleaming copper stills, fragrant botanicals like lemon myrtle and juniper, and rows of oak barrels quietly aging their signature spirits.

Tastings are guided by friendly staff who share stories behind each blend: a whisky with notes of eucalyptus, vanilla, and honey; a citrusy gin layered with native spices. This isn't just a tasting — it's a sensory journey.

The River Hotel

Lunch awaits at The River Hotel, a 1936 heritage landmark with high ceilings, dark timber beams, and vintage chandeliers. The bistro menu is built around seasonal, local produce.



- Start with grilled chicken salad — tender free-range chicken on crisp greens, avocado, and citrus vinaigrette.
- Or try the roasted vegetable tart with buttery pastry, caramelised root vegetables, and creamy goat's cheese.
- End with a classic warm apple crumble, served with vanilla bean ice cream — the perfect balance of sweet, tart, and comfort.

Mammoth Cave

In the afternoon, descend into the mystical Mammoth Cave, a limestone wonder that stretches deep beneath the karri forest. Wooden boardwalks wind through ancient chambers where stalactites glitter in soft light, and fossils of prehistoric megafauna whisper stories from 50,000 years ago.

The first chamber is fully accessible, ensuring everyone can experience the magic. As you walk, the audio guide enriches your journey with natural history and myth.



Miki's Open Kitchen

As the sun sets, prepare for the culinary highlight of the trip: a dinner experience at Miki's Open Kitchen. This restaurant is the crown jewel of Margaret River's dining scene — intimate, elegant, and booked out months in advance.

Chef Miki blends Japanese omakase tradition with premium Western Australian ingredients, creating a 23-course tasting menu that unfolds like poetry. Each dish is crafted before your eyes in an open kitchen, where the rhythmic movement of knives and flames becomes a performance.

Sample dishes include:

- **Esperance scallops with yuzu foam**, a delicate ocean kiss with citrus brightness.
- **Smoked eel nigiri crowned with local truffles**
- **Miso-glazed Margaret River Wagyu**, seared to buttery perfection.
- **Matcha mousse with candied citrus** for a gentle, aromatic finale.

Optional sake or wine pairings are curated to match each dish, elevating the experience into a symphony of flavour. Return to our accommodation for a serene night — a gentle breeze through the trees, a heart full of stories, and a palate still singing.





Margaret River Town

Continue your immersion in Margaret River, where the town's vibrant community fosters a culture of creativity with local artisans, farmers' markets, and craft breweries. Its proximity to pristine beaches and ancient forests makes it a perfect blend of relaxation and adventure, offering a timeless escape into Western Australia's heart.

After enjoying a hearty à la carte brunch in Margaret River this morning, spend some time exploring the town and making wonderful memories on your final day in this beautiful little destination.

DAY 3

Vineyard Elegance: A Grand Finale at Leeuwin Estate



Leeuwin Estate

Your final stop is Leeuwin Estate, one of the world's most respected wineries. Here, art, wine, and fine dining intertwine to create an experience that defines Margaret River luxury.

The restaurant overlooks endless vineyards through floor-to-ceiling windows. Sunlight pours in, crystal glasses sparkle, and crisp white linens set the stage for a meal that's less about eating and more about celebrating the land.

Three-Course Signature Lunch — A Seasonal Culinary Symphony (The winery changes its menu according to the season).

Entrée — *Seared kangaroo loin with wattleseed beetroot reduction*

Pink, tender kangaroo loin seared just to lock in its natural sweetness. Paired with earthy wattleseed and roasted hazelnuts, this dish is a love letter to native Australian ingredients.

Main — *Pan-roasted barramundi with herb crust, cauliflower purée and charred asparagus*

The fish's crisp skin gives way to silky white flesh, balanced by the creaminess of cauliflower purée and the brightness of charred greens. A drizzle of citrus white wine sauce elevates every bite.

Dessert — *Dark chocolate tart with honeycomb and vanilla bean ice cream*

A rich, decadent finish with just the right touch of sweetness, enhanced by West Australian honey and a sprinkle of sea salt.

Pairing with selected wines from the winery (at your own expense) Wine pairings feature the winery's iconic Art Series Chardonnay and Art Series Cabernet Sauvignon, each selected to complement the menu's delicate layers of flavour.

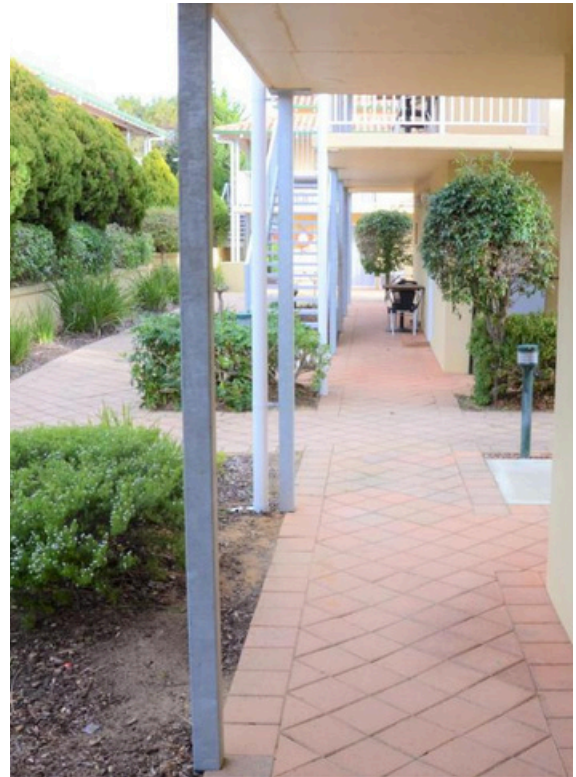
This is not just a meal — it's the grand finale of your journey, an elegant farewell surrounded by vines and the soft hum of the wind through the leaves.

The climate is pleasant but with significant temperature variations between day and night, especially in autumn and winter. To ensure a comfortable and enjoyable tasting tour, it is recommended to bring the following:

- 01** Lightweight outdoor clothing and slip-resistant shoes

- 02** Light jacket or warm clothing

- 03** Sunglasses and sunscreen

- 04** Reusable water bottle

- 05** Camera or mobile phone

- 06** Personal medications, sunscreen, and insect repellent

- 07** Personal toiletries and daily necessities
